### Apply for a SWE Scholarship!

Deadline: Feb 15

In 2021, SWE awarded 260 new and renewed scholarships valued at more than \$1,180,000. SWE Scholarships support those who identify as a female/woman and are pursuing an associate, bachelor, or graduate degree in engineering, engineering tech, and computer

science in the US and internationally.



Students complete one additional application and are considered for all scholarships for which they are eligible. The application process is entirely online including submission of recommendation letters and transcripts.

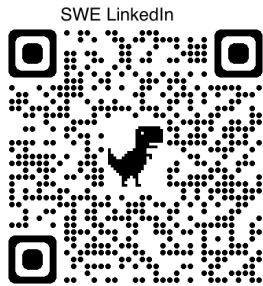

Systems Engineering Graduate Certificate from Clemson

The interdisciplinary graduate certificate in Systems Engineering is designed to equip professionals in a variety of professional settings and industries to use systems thinking and engineering theories to solve complex prob-

lems. After the completion of the graduate certificate, students are eligible for application and admittance to the Master of Engineering: Systems Engineering program. Certificate courses can be completed in-person on Clemson's main campus or at the

Zucker Family Institute in Charleston, SC. Additionally, students may elect to complete courses 100% online to accommodate their schedules or geographic location.
